1. Classes may be held outdoors or indoors.
2. Trophy and 6 ribbons awarded in each class.  
Championship and reserve in each division.
3. Leg wraps or boots may be penalized in any division. Hackamores and martingales may be penalized at the judges discretion.
4. Classes will run in the order listed. Management reserves the right to cancel, divide or combine classes if the entries warrant.
5. Entry fee is \$18 per class. Fax entry to 203-393-9640.  
No Telephone Entries. Deadline for entry is the Friday before the show at 5:00 pm. Cash, Checks, & Mastercard accepted at the Secretary's Desk
6. Schooling will be allowed at designated times; 7:00 - 7:45 before the show and at scheduled breaks during the day.
7. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the show management, but River's Edge Farm, LLC will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur.  
It shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold River's Edge Farm, LLC and it's employees and agents harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any dispute arise, it shall be referred to the management whose decision shall be final.
8. Proper attire is strongly encouraged but not mandatory except for headgear according to USEF rules.
9. In order to be eligible for Trainers or Riders Series Awards you must have attended/competed in 3 out of the 4 shows.

Directions to: RIVERS EDGE FARM

**From I-84 (East or West):** Take Exit 23, go South on Rt. 69 through Waterbury into Prospect. After the light at the intersection of Rt. 69 and Rt. 42 continue another 3.7 miles. Go to Bethway Road and take a right. Go to the second driveway on the left.

**From Route 8 (North or South):** Take Exit 22, go east on Route 67 approx. 4.5 miles. At end of Route 67 take a right onto Route 63 south continue exactly 1.4 miles to left onto Clark Road follow to end. Take a left onto Route 69 north go approx. 3.5 miles, take a left onto Bethway Rd. and go to the second driveway on the left.

**From I-95 (North or South):** Take Exit 47, go North on Rt. 34 to Ella Grasso Blvd. (Rt. 10) and go right. Go to Whalley Ave. and go left (Rt. 10). Continue on Whalley Ave. (Rt. 10 splits off to the right, but continue on Whalley). Go thru several lights until Rt. 69 bears to the right (see Wallgreens on right). Go under Rt. 15 and continue approx. 5 miles to Bethway Road. Take a left onto Bethway Rd. and go to the second driveway on the left.
